Luke 6:45 NASB</p>	<p>So also you, unless you utter by the tongue speech that is clear, how will it be known what is spoken? For you will be speaking into the air. 1 Corinthians 14:9 NASB</p>
<p>Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give grace to those who hear. Ω Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Ω Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. Ephesians 4:29-31 NASB</p>	<p>But now you also, put them all aside: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and abusive speech from your mouth. Colossians 3:8 NASB</p>
<p>Conduct yourselves with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of the opportunity. Ω Let your speech always be with grace, as though seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should respond to each person. Colossians 4:5-6 NASB</p>	<p>Let no one look down on your youthfulness, but rather in speech, conduct, love, faith and purity, show yourself an example of those who believe. 1 Timothy 4:12 NASB</p>

<p>But as for you, speak the things which are fitting for sound doctrine. Titus 2:1 NASB</p>	<p>in all things show yourself to be an example of good deeds, with purity in doctrine, dignified, sound in speech which is beyond reproach, so that the opponent will be put to shame, having nothing bad to say about us.
